

Create session (63-70).

What is a session?

Boot up PT

- Create new session (command n)
- 16 bit/44.1 CD standard...best if not a lot of editing. Otherwise have to truncate audio to burn CD.
- WAV (wave...Waveform audio format)
The WAV format is limited to files that are less than 4 GB in size, (some programs limit the file size between 2-4 GB). About 6.6 hours of CD-quality audio (44.1 kHz, 16-bit stereo)
- AIFF Audio Interchange File Format
...supposed to handle up to 2 GB
- Open folder and note the folders...they all HAVE to stay together in that folder!
- Save session. Command S template.
- Auto Back
up...setup>preferences>operation.
- While in preferences (display), look at:
 - Edit window default length
 - Color coding
 - (operation)Timeline insertion follows playback (turn off for MIDI loops)
- See save copy (to thumb drive...but can't play it from thumb

Screen overview-edit (49-50)

- 2 windows...edit mix
- command = to switch

Create MIDI tracks / channel strip (432-433).

- shift command n
- track display
- can put extra info from mix page on edit...but not good idea
 - edit window (below grid mode buttons)

Mix (30-31) screens.

Create another MIDI track.

Move to right.

Transport controls (135-136).
